CURIOSITY

The name comes from the Latin "muscum" (moss), referring to its typical aroma. It is an aromatic vine spread throughout the Mediterranean basin since ancient times, as evidenced by the documents of the early 1300s, in which it is mentioned the cultivation of Moscato in Piedmont.

The term "Moscato" appears in the Middle Ages also with the meaning of "scented": in fact, the term "muscus" or "muscatum" originally referred to an essence used in the most precious perfumery.
